PEYRONIE'S DISEASE

A 39 years old male began to suffer from a curvature in the penis a year ago and a diagnosis of Peyronie's Disease was made. The disease presentation is of a curvature in the penis, not accompanied by pain. In a dynamic duplex test a calcification in the left subcoronary region was found. Previous treatments included steroid injections to the plaque region but with no success. Background illness: NIDDM since 1986 -treated with insulin + oral hypoglycemics medications. The patient excludes regional trauma. Recently a shock wave therapy was applied by **Orthospec™**.

Treatment protocol: **Session I - 2000 shocks directed to the indurated plaque were delivered.**
Session II - 2500 shocks directed to the indurated plaque were given.

Sessions Interval: 6 weeks

Treatment results: (follow-up after two weeks)
